## English Teacher for Korean Camp

Asia Pacific Schools is looking for **3 native English speakers** to conduct English lessons for our upcoming Korean Camp. Join us from July 17<sup>th</sup> to August 11<sup>th</sup> 2023 and be a part of an unforgettable experience!

The main goal of the English lessons is to improve the communication and vocabulary skills of the students. Teachers are expected to conduct 2-3 hours of lessons a day, with the use of speaking, listening, reading, writing, and grammar exercises. Korean Teacher Assistants will also be present for most of the lessons to aid with simple translation should there be a need.

The 4-week lessons will include an English language assessment (written/oral) adapted from the Learning Village and cover topics such as:

- Likes/dislikes
- Food
- Animals
- Music
- Sport
- Useful school language – days of the week, directions, classroom objects, school subjects, etc.
- Interests/hobbies

Students will showcase what they have learned through a performance at the closing ceremony of the camp. Examples of performances include a reading of The Very Hungry Caterpillar, singing (English K-Pop songs), a video tour of the school, and a presentation on what they have learned about Malaysia.

Assessment(s) and teaching materials will be shared and provided by the school's EAL Lead.

Candidates must have the right to work in Malaysia with previous teaching experience at an international school. Having a teaching diploma is an advantage.
